That's the beauty of this program — we encourage accepted participants to incorporate whatever creative medium they prefer into their project!

Scholarship Opportunities

A total of \$5,000 in scholarships will be awarded to up to 9 participants who submit the best "end of the program" project that reflects their time during the program. Scholarship amounts may range from \$300 to \$1,000. The scholarships will be awarded at a celebration in March 2025 to honor all participants as well as give them the space to showcase their projects. There is no cost to participate in this program.

To Qualify

To qualify for the program, participants should be current students or recent graduates. Space is limited and acceptance is highly competitive, so only those who exhibit a strong resonation with this program in this application will be considered.
