
Economic Overview





hairpinning flowers.













I like traveling, so I went to Badaguan in Qingdao, she told me that she also wanted to travel and see the nature

The small powder stove, whose scientific name is the antique Furong stone pan chi ear cover stove, is a famous exhibition of the Nanjing Museum. It was born in the Qianlong period of the Qing Dynasty and attracted much attention because of its pink appearance and unique shape. The small powder stove is carved fro→m a piece of powder crystal original stone from Sri Lanka. It is 17 cm high and 14.9 cm in diameter. The whole body is full of natural veins of different lengths and the same size. The shape is clumsy and thick, and the carving is fine.





Holidays and Foods

Traditional Chinese food is dumplings: it is an important food during the Spring Festival, symbolizing reunion and welcoming the new year. More bags stuffing, by boiling or frying, frying, steaming and other methods processing mature.

In addition, there are spring cakes: the ancient beginning of spring to eat flour cake, baked very thin, also known as pancakes. Eat with several kinds of lettuce, then the number is spring plate.

We will eat yuanxiao on the Lantern Festival: the north eats yuanxiao on the fifteenth day of the first lunar month, and the south eats glutinous rice ball. Yuanxiao was very popular in the Song Dynasty. It was first called "Floating Yuanzi" and later called "Yuanxiao". Businessmen also euphemistically called it "ingot". Usually with sugar, rose, sesame, bean paste, cinnamon, walnut, nuts, jujube mud and other raw materials as the filling, wrapped with glutinous rice flour into a circle.

Some food that is usually eaten here would be hamburgers and pizza but because it is very diverse here, there are many food options. Fast food is very popular. Places like Chipotle serve Mexican fast food and it is popular among many. There are many small towns and areas where ethic groups reside and you can find many authentic cultural foods in such areas. The Spring Festival

The Chinese Spring Festival, also called Lunar New Year comes on the first day of Chinese lunar calendar and ends with the Lantern Festival. Being one of the Chinese traditional festivals, it is the grandestand the most important festival for Chinese people. It is said that the "Nian"(year) was a strong monster.People usered color and firework or firecrackers to drive away "Nian". As a result, the custom of using red color and setting off fireworksremains.

New clothes must be bought, especially children. Couplets

are pasted at both sides of the gates. The Chinese character "Fu" is pasted on the center of the door and paper-cut pictures adorn windows. Dumplings and the reun dinner are indispensable at this time. Colo and hot dishes are all served. Fish is alway an important dish then, which expresses people's hope of having a wealthy year

The American higher education system emphasizes general education and critical thinking. Students are often required to take courses in multiple fields during their undergraduate years, and final exams may cover a wide range of knowledge points. The content of the exam is not limited to textbook knowledge, but may also include class discussions, case studies, etc.

China's university education system pays more attention to the depth of professional knowledge. Students usually decide the direction of their major at the time of admission, and the final examination content is more concentrated on the knowledge points of professional courses, and the examination form is relatively traditional.


The final exam in China is relatively simple in form,

attention to students' comprehension and
application skills than to simple memory.

The final exam in China is relatively simple in form, mainly consisting of closed-book written exams, with emphasis on students' mastery and memory of textbook knowledge. Some courses may have lab or design exams, but overall, written exams dominate.


